

CQ Championship Update 03/02/10

At a specially convened management meeting last night, the following decisions were taken in relation to the 2010 CQ Championships:

1. CQ Management Committee accepted Gladstone Swimming Club's proposal to host the 2010 CQ Championships at the Gladstone Aquatic centre on 12-14 March 2010.
2. To share in the CQ Championship Prize-money Pool a CQ registered swimmer would be required to break a CQ Allcomers Record for their age division.

3. Passed the following motion:

"that by using the RACQ Trip Planner to calculate distance between towns, CQSA will provide a travel subsidy to those clubs with members attending the Central Queensland Championships in 2010 as follows:

Clubs located in a town with a return travel distance of less than 350 kilometres to the town hosting the CQ Championships will not receive a travel subsidy.

Clubs located in a town with a return travel distance between 351 and 550 kilometres to the town hosting the CQ Championships will receive a travel subsidy equivalent to 20% of that club's swimmer nominations for the meet.

Clubs located in a town with a return travel distance between 551 and 850 kilometres to the town hosting the CQ Championships will receive a travel subsidy equivalent to 40% of that club's swimmer nominations for the meet.

Club's located in a town with a return travel distance between 851 and 1350 kilometres to the town hosting the CQ Championships will receive a travel subsidy equivalent to 70% of that club's CQ swimmer nominations for the meet.

Club's located in a town with a return travel distance greater than 1351 kilometres to the town hosting the CQ Championships will receive a travel subsidy equivalent to 100% of that club's CQ swimmer nominations".

4. Through SQ, a submission has been put to McDonalds to provide [through their sponsorship] several CQ Association awards that can be presented yearly.
